Even our youngest students have a good understanding of the pillars of Lent. Good faith habits and the instruction of Gospel values has to start early! At DSCS we pride ourselves on the fact that we include even our youngest students in all of our faith experiences. Grants, grants and more grants! Last week I shared with you that we applied for a Bruce Krier Grant to help with school safety. These are only a few of our grant purchases made over the years. The grants mean that money does not come out of our school budget. The grants mean that we are able to advance the school, while still being very fiscally responsible. I must also mention that our Day of Giving and Sponsor a Classroom initiatives have helped us to collect donations to meet the needs of our teachers, without putting a strain on the school budget.
