**Blood Drive for American Red Cross** – our Blood Drive was held on Monday, Oct. 13 from 1:00 - 6:00 in the Parish Center. We collected 42 units of blood.

Eternal Life Tree for All Souls' Day – The Eternal Life tree was setup on Wed., Oct. 29 after Mass and will be taken down Wednesday, Nov. 26. Letters were sent to families who lost a loved one during the past year inviting them to the weekend Masses on Nov. 1/2, where the names of the deceased in the cluster were read at the beginning of the weekend Masses. This is now a cluster event. Each church puts up an Eternal Life Tree and a banner listing the parishioners that died during 2025 for the month of November. Also 33 small vigil candles were lite in front of the main altar for All Souls' weekend. On Sunday, Nov. 2, Dacada held a service at 1:00 pm to remember the deceased. Leon Jacoby led All Souls' Day cemetery services on Sunday, Nov. 2 in Random Lake, Adell, Cascade, Holy Cross and Lake Church.

**Gables Stocking Stuffers** -This year we are again making Christmas stockings to be given out on St. Nicholas Day. Deb Hamm has made the stockings. The committee will hand out a list of suggested stocking stuffers to parishioners on Nov. 16. We will stuff the stockings in the parish center at our December 1 meeting.
