2. **Education Home and School report- Lynn Sauer**
 - *Catholic Schools week is occurring from Jan. 25-Feb. 1. Many activities surrounded the week.
 - *Fr. Ariel Orozco started visiting the school. He will be meeting with Terri Riesselmann to develop a schedule to include time at the school and Faith Formation classes. He will be with us through the 3rd Tuesday in June.
 - *Quotes are being gathered for windows at the school.
 - *DSCS has been awarded an \$8,000 grant from the Catholic Community Foundation to help offset the cost of the therapy program for students who are struggling with anxiety or challenging anger issues.
 - *The Middle School students are studying the Saints and organized a Saint Fair in December.

3. **Parish Director's Report: Deb Hamm**
 - *Lisbon Creek, the Audio-Visual company attempted to finish the speaker installation at OLL, but did not have the correct wiring. They will come back to complete the job when they have the correct product. Microphone options for both priests are being addressed. They will schedule a time to come to Divine Savior in the next few weeks.
 - *Deb will be meeting with representatives from Life's Connection. This is a resource for parishioners who are experiencing pregnancy loss and they will provide Deb and the parishes with materials and resources that can be utilized during that difficult time.
 - *The Archdiocese is in the process of reorganizing. Please be patient as they work on their website to smooth out glitches. They may decide to sell the current building as needs have changed over time and the current structure doesn't meet current needs.
 - *Archbishop Grob will be speaking to the Faith Formation classes on Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2026 about Demonology at 6:30 at the OLL site.
 - *Bryan Bichler and Jim Barton organized an usher training for the ushers at OLL in December, 2025. They were able to be instructed on CPR. Further training will be conducted in the future.
