2. Education Home and School report- Lynn Sauer

*The staff is utilizing a new assessment program, iReady, which will replace AIMS for progress monitoring.

*The 4K-3rd grade classes have begun implementing *Fundations* (reading/phonics program)

*Mrs. Sauer submitted a Love One Another Grant for new Bibles for all the classrooms and was awarded the grant.

*Mrs. Sauer and Mrs. Pierson submitted a Bruce Krier grant for a Health and Safety grant for Stop the Bleed kits, an AED, new flooring and new lunch tables. The grant for \$73,000 was awarded to DSCS.

*The Fourth grade teaching position has been filled by Amanda Longden.

*Fr. Pat will no longer be the school priest. Fr. Don will now be assigned to the school with Fr. Steve available when Fr. Don is unavailable. The school thanks Fr. Pat for his dedication and service to the community.
