Old Business

- Adoration on Thursday's was discussed. Seems to be going well. There will be four candles lit, two on the altar and the two on the sides of the tabernacle. The schedule is working well for the adorers.
- We will be adding an announcement box to the bulletin stating our Adoration hours. It will show up periodically when there is room.
- February 29th Encounter night was very well attended. Music was beautiful and confessions flowed seamlessly. Fr. Tom gave a wonderful talk on Eucharist. Next Encounter will be April 24th at Holy Cross at 6:30. We will have the same format. Deb is looking for a speaker. We will have three confessors again. Tim Shinniger family will provide worship music again.
- Ecumenical Group Lenten Service we hosted on February 28th was well attended. The topic was Jesus' Robe. Deb led the service with refreshments following.

New Business

- Our Lenten series is underway with Dr. David Stosur speaking on Eucharistic Spirituality. The dates are March 5, 12, and 19. As of this date, there were 61 attendees for the March 5th night. There will be a break for Easter. To finish up, there will be two additional sessions. April 16 and 23 at 7 p.m.. No Mass or meal at these, we will only serve desserts. OLL is the host site. The first night was very well attended. We begin with Mass at 6:00, soup served after Mass and the presentation follows at 7:00.
- Fr. Don will have a teaching Mass on March 13th for the religious ed students. All parishioners are welcome.
- We had a brief discussion on the possibility of opening up the church during the day for
 private prayer. There has been a request from a parishioner who goes elsewhere to pray.
 Deb explained that our insurance lady would like people present in the church when it's
 open. The insurance company is ok with the one day, Wednesday, open after mass for

personal prayer. If anyone wants to go to church for private prayer, they can call the office and someone will go over and open the door, and you lock it when you leave.
