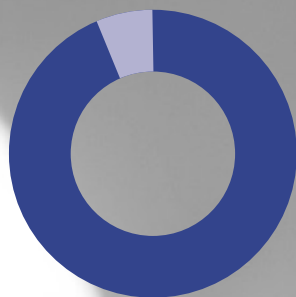

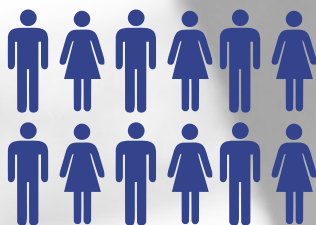

Believing that every child should have the opportunity to learn, former Archbishop Joseph P. Hurley asked the Sisters of St. Joseph of St. Augustine to pioneer five Morning Star schools. These became Florida's first schools for children with intellectual disabilities. Under the direction of Sister Elizabeth Marie Stoup, Morning Star Catholic School was officially established in the College Park neighborhood of Orlando in 1960. On opening day, six students attended Morning Star Catholic. Today, there are seventy students enrolled.

The goal of Morning Star Catholic School is to ensure each student has the opportunity to reach his or her potential and become an integral part of their community. We accomplish this by providing each child with special needs a more energized outlook on a life filled with possibilities. We work to inspire students to focus beyond limitations, embrace their potential, and encourage individual responsibility, in order to ultimately enable our students to function more independently and become active and effective participants in today's world.

No child has ever been turned away from Morning Star Catholic because of race, religious preference, or an inability to pay. Tuition remains minimal and our school receives no federal funding. As a result, children and families of all economic means can receive exceptional care and a quality education. The majority of our students qualify for financial assistance through grants, including the McKay Scholarship Program and Personal Learning Scholarship Accounts (PLSA). Beyond this, Morning Star Catholic School relies on the generous support of our community to make our programs and services a reality for our existing and future students.

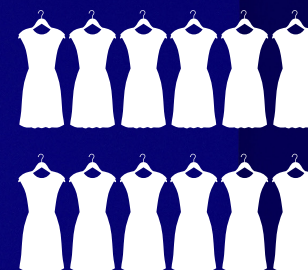


# A RUNWAY FOR GIVING
