MCS Virtual Learning Option for the 2020-2021 School Year

1. The Virtual Learning Plan is available for families who are uncomfortable returning to campus at this time for concerns related to covid-19 or because they have a child that is medically compromised, placing the child in a higher risk population for COVID-19.
2. The Virtual Learning Option is a temporary measure which can be ended at the school's discretion upon consultation with and guidance from diocesan officials.
3. Families that choose this option, must commit to a minimum of nine weeks. The administration reserves the right to review any virtual enrollment and make changes as needed.
4. Families can register for this virtual option by contacting Leah Kessel at kessel@morningstarorlando.org. This must be done by August 7, 2020.
5. All students participating in the Virtual Learning Option must view an orientation which will be sent via a link prior to the start of school on August 26, 2020.
6. The Virtual Learning Option is not the same as the remote learning option offered last spring. Students will participate in live class sessions every day and will be expected to attend and participate in each subject/lesson throughout the entire school day (8:00am to 2:45pm).
7. Students must be present for class every day and at the time each class starts. Students missing more than 5 undocumented class periods in nine weeks will receive an Incomplete on their report card and lose the option for virtual learning.
8. Students must wear school uniforms while in virtual classes.
9. Students using this option must adhere to all policies in the Parent Student handbook.
10. All students, both those on campus and those virtually attending class must meet all academic deadlines and due dates.
11. The make-up work policy for virtual students is the same as students who are physically attending classes. See the Parent Student handbook for details.
12. Flex hours for instructors are 3:00-3:30pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Students requiring assistance should utilize this time.
13. Students who have technical issues or questions during the school day should contact Leah Kessel at 407-295-3077 or by email at kessel@morningstarorlando.org.
14. Students choosing this option may participate in extracurricular activities but may not be on campus until after dismissal of the regular school day.
15. Students choosing the Virtual Learning Option must still adhere to the attendance guidelines and expectations of state scholarships.
16. There are no discounts for tuition or fees for families using this option.
