This year's retreat is with Father John Anglin.





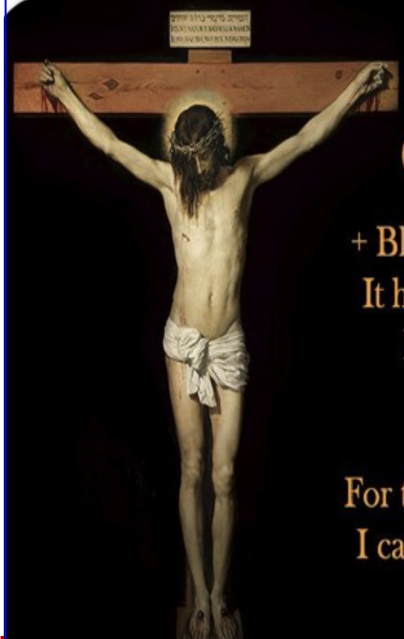
