Assessment of Readiness for Marriage

If the priest/deacon determines that the couple is prepared sufficiently for the marriage, a tentative date for the wedding may be set and further preparations made.

- 1. In the event of some special circumstance (e.g., age under 18, premarital pregnancy, parental opposition, extreme religious indifference, etc.) the couple is to be referred to a diocesan approved evaluator (another priest or lay person, preferably from the same locale, trained for evaluation) for additional evaluation prior to finalizing the assessment.
- 2. If the priest/deacon determines that either of the parties is not prepared to enter marriage, he must delay witnessing the marriage according to the norms set forth in the Delay Marriage section in the *Marriage Preparation Guidelines for the Province of New Orleans* promulgated in 2008 (see page 36 in the Canonical Requirements Section 8 Special Circumstances in the *Marriage Preparation Guidelines for the Province of New Orleans* promulgated in 2008). In the event that the proposed officiant decides the wedding must be delayed, appropriate continuing marriage preparation is to be offered to the couple. Both interviewer and officiant are urged to add personal notes and evaluative remarks to the prenuptial file, along with all required and useful documentation.
