PRIVATE PRAYER TIME AVAILABLE WITH SOCIAL DISTANCING

The Diocese is allowing parishes to open for private prayer on a limited basis. Sacred Heart will open the main church (the Adoration and Day Chapel remain closed) on Tuesdays from 9:00—11:00 AM and Thursdays from 4:00—6:00 PM beginning June 23. Following directives from the Diocese, no more than 10 people will be allowed inside a Church at one time, masks must be worn, and churches will follow social distancing guidelines. Those praying must be seated at a minimum of six feet apart. Pews are marked to identify where to sit.

CURRENT NEWS

PARISH REOPENING EXPLANATION

Sacred Heart church will begin its gradual re-opening for mass with the people on the weekend of June 27-28. Saturday night at 5 p.m. Sunday morning at 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. Admittance and seating begin 30 minutes prior to mass. This is new for all of us, be patient as we work out the details of how to do this. For this to be successful and safe we need everyone to carefully follow directions and protocols of safe distancing, wearing your mask as you come, and sanitizing. Everyone must honestly answer to God that they are feeling well to attend church. Obviously, you have no: fever, cough, sore throat, or other symptom of illness that prudence would say-- stay home for now. We will still stream/post daily masses from the parish, and stream/post Saturday night mass for those at home to view for the weekend. The dispensation is still in effect until the end of this year regarding the obligation to attend church. We will have a few masks on hand for who those who forget theirs. Donations of home sewn masks for this purpose are welcome.

All are welcome, but we encourage those age 65 and older or anyone with underlying health conditions (or someone in their household with such) to prayerfully consider if it is prudent for them to return to mass at this time, because of increasing the risk of exposure to someone who is not showing symptoms of Covid-19. We expect everyone to wear a mask (under age 2 not expected) and to respect the 6 foot distance between people during mass, as they enter and exit church, or as they stand in line to receive Communion. Please use sanitizer as you enter and exit. Those who live in the same house may sit together as a family so tell the usher this information as you are seated. We will seat people as they enter starting from the front of church, do not expect to seat yourself or to get your regular places. Also tell the usher of a disability, that necessitates sitting close to the door, but this depends on what is available. Baskets to drop your offertory in will be at the doors to the church. No bulletins will be handed out. There will be 2 empty pew (marked by tape) between each row used, and ushers will direct you where to sit to maintain a safe distance from others. Please take note of the light-colored floor tiles, they are spaced 6 feet apart.

My parish app does have the readings and prayers for mass to follow on your phones, or you may bring your own book. If you wish to use a parish missalette to share with family then you must take it home with you and then bring it back with you to use at future masses. Once you use one, it becomes your responsibility, and cannot be returned to the rack for someone else to use.

At the end of mass, please offer your reverence to Christ in the tabernacle as father and a volunteer EMC will sanitize their hands, and with masks on go to the back of church and the ushers will direct when it is your turn as a row to receive communion. Please maintain the 6-foot distance throughout. When you get to father or EMC, receive the eucharist in hand, turn and step through the exit door, before with one hand lifting your mask enough to place the Eucharist into your mouth and consuming. Continue your way to your car, with mask on. Please allow in your car a few moments of silent prayer of thanksgiving at receiving Christ, before starting on your way home. Please maintain the safe distancing on your way through the gathering area and parking lot to not impede the safe passage of others around you.

We are here to worship Christ our Lord as best we can under these conditions. Many people have contributed to the discussion of how we are doing this to balance the needs of faith, reverence, worship, and safety. By our patience and love for one another, and especially those hard pressed by these times, may we make a pleasing prayer to God on their behalf. God Bless you all.
