PASTOR'S NOTES

“Center” and “Periphery” When I was ordained I served for four and a half years at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Calexico. People would ask me what I did wrong to get exiled to the Imperial Valley. I used to joke that I loved being far away from the “center”; it gave me freedom. During that time I was involved in a youth retreat movement called Christian Awakening that caused an incredible explosion of faith and excitement in the “Valley”. As a result, I was appointed Director of the Office for Youth and Young Adult Ministry. I was no longer on the periphery; now I was at the center. I also lived and worked at our college seminary. I had two jobs and worked closely with the Bishop over the next six years. Then I was appointed pastor in San Ysidro, Fallbrook, and now in Vista. All three assignments were/are far away from the “center”. There are good things about being far away from the “center” of decision making and power in an organization. There are also negative things about being on the periphery. The same is true in parish life. Lay leaders, parish staff, deacons, and priests are all on the inside; at the “center”. There is a good side and a bad side to being on the “inside”. The average parishioners are not involved in the everyday decision making and there is a good side and a bad side to them being on the “periphery”. However, the strength of any organization, religious or secular, is its ability to bring the “center” and the “periphery” together. The more power becomes centralized and the less the rank and file are involved in decision making, the more often there are abuses of power, and decisions are made that do not benefit the “common good”. One of the most influential Catholic theologians of the past century was a French Dominican by the name of Yves Congar. One of his most important books, published in 1950, is called, “True and False Reform in the Church.” Congar, less than four years after publishing this book, was sent into exile by his order, away from his friends and his books and his life’s work. Pope John the XXIII would read his book a few years later. Many believe he was inspired by it to call for The Council and aggiornamento (an opening of the church). Pope John Paul II named him a Cardinal shortly before he died, acknowledging his great contribution to the Church. Congar’s work was driven by a desire to clarify the equally necessary roles of the “center” (hierarchical leadership) and the “periphery” (local churches with their pastors and people). Congar spent a great deal of time analyzing the necessary tension between the “center” and the “periphery” and arguing for their complementary and necessary roles. He argued that the “periphery” had a necessary role in bringing the church’s preaching and witness to every culture;

adjusting the life and practices of the church to the human dynamics of linguistically, culturally, and historically diverse nations; and devising initiatives to bridge the gap between what is familiar and what is urgently needed. What does all this have to do with you and me? As a local Christian community, the tension and interplay between the members and the leaders should not be ignored, and the importance of the leadership listening to its members not underestimated. Our “One2One” listening campaign is a real attempt of leadership to listen to membership. Every member of the Body of Christ has a contribution to make to the “common good”. Only when all members do their part, are heard, and leadership strives for the “common good”, can the Body flourish! My prayer for us is that we can bridge the distance between the “center” and “periphery” by listening to each other, and working together for the “common good” building up the Body of Christ here at St. Francis of Assisi.

CONCLUDING RITES

When it is necessary, **announcements may be made**. The celebrant then blesses the people assembled. Sometimes, the blessing is very simple. On special days, the blessing may be more extensive.

After the blessing, **the deacon dismisses the people**. In fact, the dismissal gives the liturgy its name. The word "Mass" comes from the Latin word, "*Missa*." At one time, the people were dismissed with the words "*Ite, missa est*," meaning "Go, you are sent. The word "*Missa*" comes from the word "*missio*," the root of the English word "mission." The liturgy does not simply come to an end. Those assembled are sent forth to bring the fruits of the Eucharist to the world.

Phép Lạ Giáng Sinh

Hằng năm, cứ đến Giáng Sinh, Hải Nhi Giêsu thường đi một vòng rào qua khắp các làng mạc và đô thị để tặng quà cũng như nhận quà và phân phát cho những ai cần đến.

Năm nay, tại một đô thị nọ, Ngài đang cần một món quà không dễ tìm ra: đó là một quả tim lành mạnh để thay thế quả tim của một người bệnh đang hấp hối. Bệnh nhân có quả tim gần như ngừng đập này là một nhân vật nổi tiếng trong cả nước: đó là bộ trưởng tài chính!

Tất cả các bác sĩ trong nước đều bó tay. Cuối cùng, họ mới chạy đến với Hải Nhi Giêsu, vì tin tưởng rằng ít ra trong đêm Giáng Sinh, Ngài sẽ làm một phép lạ. Nhưng Hải Nhi Giêsu trả lời với các bác sĩ: "Không phải Ta là người phải làm phép lạ, nhưng chính là lòng quảng đại của một người dâng hiến quả tim của mình".

Tin tưởng ở lòng người, Hải Nhi Giêsu đã đến gõ cửa nhà của thân nhân, bạn hữu của vị bộ trưởng. Họ đang mừng lễ Giáng Sinh: cây Giáng Sinh của họ đầy những hoa đèn và quà tặng, bàn ăn của họ đầy những thịt rượu và của ngon vật lạ. Họ đang ăn uống say sưa... Vừa thấy Hải Nhi đứng trước nhà, họ tưởng Ngài là một cậu bé vô lại phá đám, cho nên đã tổng khởi Ngài đi càng sớm càng tốt. Hải Nhi Giêsu buồn bã bỏ đi... Nhưng Ngài vẫn chưa thất vọng về tình người. Lần này, Ngài đến gõ cửa của những người thân cận vị bộ trưởng. Họ là những người đã từng bán đứng lương tâm, chối bỏ phẩm giá của mình để tìm kiếm lợi lộc một chút cặn bã của vinh hoa, lợi lộc phù phiếm. Hải Nhi Giêsu nghĩ thầm ít ra đây cũng là dịp để họ tỏ lòng biết ơn đối với ông bộ trưởng. Nhưng tất cả đều lác đàu từ chối, trái tim của họ đang hướng đến người sẽ lên thay thế ông bộ trưởng trong những ngày gần đây.

Hải Nhi Giêsu lại tiếp tục đi gõ cửa từng nhà, nhưng ai cũng đang bận bịu với cuộc vui đêm Giáng Sinh.

Ngài đi, đi mãi trong đêm, để rồi mệt lả không còn lê bước nữa. Ngài ngồi xuống bên vệ đường ven đô thị. Ngài đang miên man nghĩ đến tình người thì bỗng dưới ánh đèn đường mờ ảo, một bóng đen thất thểu tiến lại gần Ngài. Con người này xem chừng như không biết lễ Giáng Sinh là gì. Quần áo bẩn thỉu, dáng đi ngập ngừng. Trên vai của anh đeo lưng lửng một chiếc đàn vĩ cầm cũ kỹ. Đó là tất cả vốn liếng của một kẻ lãng tử. Vừa thấy em bé ngồi tiu nghỉu bên vệ đường, anh mới dừng lại, lấy chiếc đàn ra và dạo lên những khúc nhạc du dương, trầm buồn. Bản nhạc bỗng mang lại hy vọng cho Hải Nhi. Trên môi Ngài, một nụ cười bé thơ cũng vừa hé mở. Con người lang thang phiêu bạt này, con người không có lấy một mái nhà để nương náu, không có được một ngày lễ trong cuộc sống, không biết được đêm nay là đêm Giáng Sinh: vậy mà con người ấy có được một trái tim quảng đại sẵn sàng dâng hiến!

Hải Nhi Giêsu đến nắm tay anh, đưa anh vào bệnh viện. Tại đây, với nụ cười tươi nở trên môi, anh để cho các bác sĩ khoét vào lồng ngực của anh để lấy quả tim quảng đại của anh và đặt vào chỗ của quả tim đang thoi thóp của ông bộ trưởng tài chính.

Cuộc ghép tim vừa chấm dứt, thì mọi người đã có thể chứng kiến được phép lạ. Ông bộ trưởng với quả tim quảng đại và yêu đời của người lãng tử đứng dậy khỏi giường và bắt đầu ca hát.

Ông đã ném đi quả tim chỉ biết rung động vì tiền của, để thay thế bằng quả tim quảng đại biết ca hát, và sẵn sàng tự hiến cho người.

Mensaje del Párroco

“Centro” y “Periferia”.... Cuando fui ordenado serví por cuatro años y medio en la Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en Calexico. A la gente le preguntaba preguntarme si había hecho algo malo para ser exiliado a Imperial Valley. Yo les decía que me gustaba estar lejos del “centro”; lo que me daba cierta libertad. Durante ese tiempo estuve participando en el movimiento de retiros para jóvenes llamado Despertar Cristiano que causó una increíble explosión de fe y entusiasmo en el “Valle”. Como resultado se me nombró Director de la Oficina diocesana de Jóvenes y Jóvenes Adultos. Yo no estuve más en la “periferia”; ahora yo estaba en el “centro”. Vivía y trabajaba en nuestro Colegio-Seminario. Tenía dos trabajos y trabajaba muy cerca con el Obispo, y lo hice por seis años. Después fui nombrado párroco en San Isidro, en Fallbrook, y ahora en Vista. Los tres nombramientos fueron/son lejos del “centro”. Hay buenas cosas al estar lejos del “centro” donde se hacen las decisiones y existe el poder de la organización. También hay cosas negativas al estar en la “periferia”. Lo mismo sucede en la vida de la parroquia. Líderes laicos, Personal parroquial, diáconos y sacerdotes, todos están dentro; en el “centro”. Y hay cosas buenas y malas de estar “dentro”. La mayoría de los feligreses no participan en las decisiones diarias; y existen buenas y malas cosas para ellos al estar en la “periferia”. Sin embargo, la fortaleza de una organización, de un grupo religioso o secular descansa en su habilidad de mantener unidos al “centro” y a la “periferia”. Sin embargo, entre más se encuentre el poder centralizado y las decisiones sean tomadas por el centro, habrá con mayor frecuencia abusos de poder, y las decisiones no se tomarán para “el bien común”. Uno de los teólogos católicos más influyentes del siglo pasado fue el dominico francés llamado Yves Congar. Uno de sus libros más importantes publicado en 1950 fue “La Verdadera y Falsa Reforma en la Iglesia”. Poco menos de cuatro años de haber publicado su libro, Congar fue exiliado de su Orden, se le puso lejos de sus amigos, sus libros y de su trabajo. El Papa Juan XXIII pudo haber leído su libro años después. Y muchos creen que ese libro le motivó para convocar el Concilio y el Aggiornamento (apertura de la Iglesia). El Papa Juan Pablo II lo nombró Cardenal antes de morir, reconociendo su gran contribución a la Iglesia. El trabajo de Congar fue guiado por un deseo de poner en claro la igualdad necesaria en las actividades del “centro” (liderazgo jerárquico) y de la “periferia” (iglesias locales con sus pastores y la gente). Congar dedicó bastante tiempo

analizando la tensión que existía entre el “centro” y la “periferia” y discutía sobre las actividades complementarias y necesarias. Discutía sobre el papel necesario que la “periferia” tenía de traer el testimonio y predicación de cada cultura; el ajustar la vida y las prácticas de la iglesia con la dinámica humana en lo lingüístico, cultural y la diversidad histórica de las naciones; y crear iniciativas que sobrepasaran el hueco entre lo que es conocido y lo que es urgentemente necesario. Todo esto, ¿qué tiene que ver conmigo y con ustedes? Como una comunidad cristiana local, la tensión y la interrelación entre sus miembros y sus líderes no debe ser ignorada; y la importancia de que sus líderes escuchen a sus miembros, no debe ser tenida en poco valor. Nuestra Campaña de escuchar “Uno a Uno” es un intento real para que nuestros líderes escuchen a los miembros. Cada miembro del Cuerpo de Cristo tiene una contribución para “el bien común”. Solo cuando todos los miembros hagan su parte, sean escuchados y el liderazgo se esfuerce por el “bien común” ¡podrá florecer todo su Cuerpo! Mi oración por nosotros es que podemos realizar un puente entre el “centro” y la “periferia” escuchándonos unos a otros y trabajando juntos por el “bien común” construyendo el Cuerpo de Cristo aquí en la parroquia de San Francisco de Asís.
