PASTOR'S NOTES

Diagnosis = Listening.....! A central part of modern life, especially in Southern California, is way you get from one place to another. Most people in our neck of the woods get from place to place via a car. Some of us rely on rapid transportation, but let's face it, rapid transportation limits your ability to get to many places in our area; and at present, it is not a very fast way to travel. I have used the Sprinter, the Coaster, and the Trolley a couple of times, but I mainly rely on my truck. I have been around a number of elderly folks who have had to relinquish their keys and stop driving and it is very traumatic for them. It means they are no longer independent and able to move about at will. Cars have evolved over the years since my first car: a VW Bug. My VW Bug was easy to work on. A non-mechanic like me was able to take out the old engine and transmission and put in a rebuilt engine and transmission, all by myself. It was a piece of cake! I used the VW Bug manual and followed the instructions and was able to do it in a weekend. I tuned my VW Bug by myself, regularly changing the spark plugs, the points, and adjusting the timing. With my Toyota Tacoma truck I really can't do much. When I backed into the garage, went too far and smashed my back-up/brake light, I ordered the new light and installed it myself, twice! But that is about it. I do NOT tune my car and I would never think of putting in a rebuilt engine or transmission. Still, when the car begins to make a noise that is not normal I wonder what it is. In a sense I begin to try to diagnose the problem. In the last month or so I have noticed a noise that sounds like a sort of rubbing. It increases until about 70 mph and then it disappears! I have also noticed that the noise stops when I turn the car to the left. This is not the case when I turn it to the right. At first I thought it was the kayak and bike racks. So I removed them and I still hear the noise. Actually it seems a little stronger now than before. I am now thinking it has something to do with the tires. I checked the pressure in the tires and they are fine. I have decided that I need to take it in to an expert to help me figure out what is wrong. Yesterday as I was walking, I was thinking about how the spiritual life and diagnosis of car problems have some things in common. First of all, neither is an exact science. Often we think one thing is wrong and really it is another; or sometimes we think God is calling us in one direction and then we discover God's call is moving us in a totally different direction from what we thought. Second, diagnosing a car is all about listening. You have to listen to the different sounds the car makes. Spi-

itual discernment is all about listening as well. We are trying to listen to the Lord in the depths of our hearts and in our everyday experiences. This can be as difficult as trying to pinpoint a noise a car is making while it is moving. It takes patience and effort to try and figure out exactly what God wants us to do. Finally, our spiritual lives are much like the life of a car, in that cars need constant service or attention. The same is true with our journey of faith. We need to be constantly reflecting and listening to the voice of God in our lives. This is what it means to be a follower of Jesus. We must be dedicated to "diagnosing"; that is, listening to our inner self. It is there that the Lord speaks to us. This is impossible without regular times of quiet or silence in our lives. Finding quiet in our busy lives is just as difficult as finding time to take our car to the mechanic, but just as important. When you finish reading this pastor's notes, stop and quiet yourself, and simply "be" in the presence of the Living God. Notice how good it is and enjoy listening to your greatest Love!!

Mensaje del Párroco

¡Diagnóstico = Escuchar.....! Una parte esencial de la vida moderna, especialmente en el sur de California, es cómo ir de un lado a otro. La mayor parte de nuestra gente en nuestro intrincado mundo, lo hace usando el carro. Algunos de nosotros confiamos en un transporte rápido, pero veámoslo de frente, la transportación rápida pone límites a la habilidad de ir a muchos lugares en nuestra área, y al presente, no es un camino rápido para viajar. He utilizado el Sprinter y el Coaster y el Trolley un par de veces, pero yo confío en mi troca. He estado alrededor de muchas personas en edad que han tenido que entregar sus llaves y dejar de manejar, lo cual ha sido muy traumático para ellos. Significa que no tienen independencia y no pueden seguir su voluntad. Varios carros he tenido desde mi primero que fue un VW Bug. Mi VW Bug fue fácil de trabajar en él. Un seudo mecánico como yo pude cambiarle yo solo la maquina antigua y la transmisión por una maquina reconstruida y una transmisión nueva. Fue muy fácil hacerlo. Utilicé el instructivo de mi VW Bug y con las instrucciones lo hice en un fin de semana. Yo solo le daba servicio total a mi VW Bug, y frecuentemente le cambiaba y calibraba las bujías y ponía a tiempo el motor. Con mi troca Toyota Tacoma no puedo hacer mucho. Una vez cuando la ponía en reversa en la cochera y fui más allá del límite rompí una calavera y se la instalé yo mismo en dos ocasiones. Y eso es todo, NO puedo poner a tiempo el motor y nunca he pensado en cambiar el motor o la transmisión. Aún, cuando la troca hace algún ruido no ordinario, no se explicar la razón. Pero con sentido común inicio un diagnostico del problema. En el último mes le he escuchado un sonido de algo que raspa. Y aumenta el sonido hasta 70 mph y luego, ¡desaparece! Y me he dado cuenta que el sonido desaparece cuando le doy vuelta a mi troca a la izquierda. Pero no desaparece cuando doy vuelta a la derecha. Al principio pensé que era un eje o el tambor de frenos. Se los cambié y todavía sigue el ruido. Y ahora esta más fuerte el ruido que antes. Ahora estoy pensando hacer algo con las llantas. Revisé la presión de cada una, y están bien. He decidido llevar la troca a un experto para que me ayude a descubrir lo que está mal. Ayer, cuando estaba realizando mi caminata estuve pensando acerca de la vida espiritual en relación con el diagnóstico de los problemas de mi troca y encontré algunas cosas en común. Primero que todo, no es una ciencia exacta. Con frecuencia, pensamos que algo está mal y realmente es otra cosa, o algunas veces, pensamos que Dios nos está llamando en una dirección, y luego, descubrimos que la llamada de Dios es completamente en otra dirección de lo que pensábamos. Segundo, el diagnóstico sobre un carro

es acerca de escuchar. Ustedes tienen que escuchar los diferentes sonidos que el carro produce. El discernimiento espiritual se centra sobre todo en el escuchar. Tratamos de escuchar al Señor en las profundidades de nuestro corazón y en las experiencias de nuestra vida diaria. Esto puede ser tan difícil como identificar el sonido que produce el carro cuando lo manejamos. Toma paciencia y esfuerzo tratar de identificar lo que realmente Dios desea que realicemos. Finalmente, nuestras vidas en lo espiritual son muy semejantes a la vida de un carro en lo que se refiere a que el carro necesita un constante servicio y atención. Es lo mismo con nuestra jornada de fe. Necesitamos estar en una constante reflexión y actitud de escuchar la voz de Dios en nuestras vidas. Esto es lo que significa ser seguidores de Jesús. Debemos estar entregados a “diagnosticar” qué significa el escuchar dentro de nosotros mismos. Es allí donde el Señor nos habla. Esto es imposible sin tiempos frecuentes de quietud y silencio en nuestras vidas. Encontrar quietud en nuestras vidas tan ocupadas es tan difícil como encontrar tiempo para llevar nuestro carro al mecánico, pero, es algo muy importante. Cuando termine de leer este Mensaje del Párroco, deténgase y quédese quieto, y simplemente “permanezca” ante la presencia de Dios vivo. ¡Descubra los efectos buenos de ello y goce el escuchar el maravilloso amor de Dios!!!

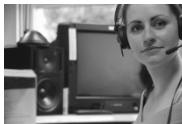
