PASTOR'S NOTES

This past week we joined the Universal Church in celebrating Ash Wednesday and with it, we began our Lenten Season. At times, Lent can become a bit burdensome because we need to keep track of all the different rules regarding fasting and abstinence. We also have to keep track of which readings we will use at Mass because the readings to be proclaimed are dependent upon whether or not we have scrutinies. Yet, in the midst of all these things of which we must keep track, the Lenten Season is a great opportunity for us to enter evermore deeper into prayer and reflection in preparation for the great Easter celebration.

Here at St. Francis, we invite you to join us during this Lenten Season in prayer and preparation for Easter. In effort to support our entire community, there are many opportunities that will help you during this blessed Season. One of the things that you will notice during Lent is that we do not have a recessional song at the end of Mass; but rather we leave in silence. In the Church's liturgical documents, we are invited to leave the Church in a prayerful mood, reminding us at the end of Mass that this season calls for interior reflection and change (cf. Ceremonial of Bishops no. 252).

During the Fridays of Lent we also have the celebration of the Stations of the Cross, in English at 6:00 pm, Vietnamese at 7:00 pm, and Spanish at 8:00 pm. All are invited to join our Lord on the "*Via Dolorosa*". The Knights of Columbus will once again host their Fish Fry each Friday of Lent before the Stations of the Cross and all are welcome to join us, building community

with our brothers and sisters of St. Francis.

Please don't let these opportunities pass you and your family by. I invite you during this Lenten Season, to encounter Jesus through prayer, fasting, and works of mercy.

Praying that this blessed Season may be a fruitful one for each of you in preparation for the joy of Easter.

News from Pope Benedict XVI

As some of you might have heard, the Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI announced earlier this morning that he will be resigning his office effective February 28th due to declining health. Early this morning, the Holy Father convoked a consistory of those Cardinals living in Rome to review some canonizations. At that time he is also made the announcements to the Cardinals. Here, is the statement from the Holy Father regarding his resignation:

"Dear Brothers, I have convoked you to this Consistory, not only for the three canonizations, but also to communicate to you a decision of great importance for the life of the Church," he said in a statement addressed to cardinals. "After having repeatedly examined my conscience before God, I have come to the certainty that my strengths, due to an advanced age, are no longer suited to an adequate exercise of the Petrine ministry."

"I am well aware that this ministry, due to its essential spiritual nature, must be carried out not only with words and deeds, but no less with prayer and suffering," he continued in his statement, which was dated February 10 and released by Vatican Radio on February 11. "However, in today's world, subject to so many rapid changes and shaken by questions of deep relevance for the life of faith, in order



to govern the bark of Saint Peter and proclaim the Gospel, both strength of mind and body are necessary, strength which in the last few months, has deteriorated in me to the extent that I have had to recognize my incapacity to adequately fulfill the ministry entrusted to me."

"For this reason, and well aware of the seriousness of this act, with full freedom I declare that I renounce the ministry of Bishop of Rome, Successor of Saint Peter, entrusted to me by the Cardinals on 19 April 2005, in such a way, that as from 28 February 2013, at 20:00 hours, the See of Rome, the See of Saint Peter, will be vacant and a Conclave to elect the new Supreme Pontiff will have to be convened by those whose competence it is," he added.

"Dear Brothers, I thank you most sincerely for all the love and work with which you have supported me in my ministry and I ask pardon for all my defects. And now, let us entrust the Holy Church to the care of Our Supreme Pastor, Our Lord Jesus Christ, and implore his holy Mother Mary, so that she may assist the Cardinal Fathers with her maternal solicitude, in electing a new Supreme Pontiff. With regard to myself, I wish to also devotedly serve the Holy Church of God in the future through a life dedicated to prayer."

Please join me in praying both for the Church as we move forward and in gratitude for the service of Pope Benedict to the Church.





Y también tenemos que estar muy pendientes de las lecturas que utilizaremos para la Misa porque se deberán de leer de acuerdo a la celebración de los Escrutinios. Mensaje del Papa Benedicto XVI

Como ustedes han escuchado, el Santo Padre, el Papa Benedicto XVI ha anunciado en el amanecer del 11 de febrero que renunciará a su ministerio pontificio el 28 de febrero debido al deterioro de su salud. Muy temprano el Santo Padre convocó a un consistorio para los Cardenales que viven en Roma, para revisar algunos procesos de canonización. Durante esa sesión el Papa dio su mensaje. Aquí tienen las palabras de su renuncia:

"Queridísimos hermanos,

Os he convocado a este Consistorio, no sólo para las tres causas de canonización, sino también para comunicaros una decisión de gran importancia para la vida de la Iglesia. Después de haber examinado ante Dios reiteradamente mi conciencia, he llegado a la certeza de que, por la edad avanzada, ya no tengo fuerzas para ejercer adecuadamente el ministerio petrino.

Soy muy consciente de que este ministerio, por su naturaleza espiritual, debe ser llevado a cabo no únicamente con obras y palabras, sino también y en no menor grado sufriendo y rezando. Sin embargo, en el mundo de hoy, sujeto a rápidas transformaciones y sacudido por cuestiones de gran relieve para la vida de la fe, para gobernar la barca de san Pedro y anunciar el Evangelio, es necesario también el vigor tanto del cuerpo como del espíritu, vigor que, en los últimos meses, ha disminuido en mí de tal forma que he de reconocer mi incapacidad para ejercer bien el ministerio que me fue encomendado.

Por esto, siendo muy consciente de la seriedad de este acto, con plena libertad, declaro que renuncio al ministerio de Obispo de Roma, Sucesor de San Pedro, que me fue confiado por medio de los Cardenales el 19 de abril de 2005, de forma que, desde el 28 de febrero de 2013, a las 20.00 horas, la sede de Roma, la sede de San Pedro, quedará vacante y deberá ser convocado, por medio de quien tiene competencias, el cónclave para la elección del nuevo Sumo Pontífice.

Queridísimos hermanos, os doy las gracias de corazón por todo el amor y el trabajo con que habéis llevado junto a mí el peso de mi ministerio, y pido perdón por todos mis defectos. Ahora, confiamos la Iglesia al cuidado de su Sumo Pastor, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, y suplicamos a María, su Santa Madre, que asista con su materna bondad a los Padres Cardenales al elegir el nuevo Sumo Pontífice. Por lo que a mí respecta, también en el futuro, quisiera servir de todo corazón a la Santa Iglesia de Dios con una vida dedicada a la plegaria"

Por favor, únanse a mi en oración tanto por el avance de la Iglesia como en gratitud por el servicio pastoral del Papa Benedicto XVI a la Iglesia.



