- The provisional Zoom meeting began at 7:10pm
- Brother Bob DeMaggio mentioned that brother Al Lopez had successfully set up the printing station for the monthly council NewsLetter, although that he would still need help preparing the papers for sending.
- The Instillation of new officers was said to be still on the newsletter although may be delayed until further notice due to the ongoing pandemic.
- It was mentioned that Father Ricardo had recently gotten a new bed and help was needed to help pay for it. As of the time of the general meeting a Knight from San Marcos had already fronted the money for Father Ricardo's bed with his charge card a total of \$1885.48. After discussion the council decided that our council should pay for the bed directly from the general fund. Although the council would be reimbursed directly by the Palomar KayCee Club for the cost of the bed.
- Also after discussion by Deputy Grand Knight Candelario Barbosa it was decided that a contribution should also be made to our parish. This is as a result of the decrease in collections on sundays due to the ongoing pandemic. An amount of \$5000 was decided to be given by Palomar KayCee Club directly to the parish.
- It was mentioned that the memorial mass would be held on the 2nd of November and that a donation of \$50.00 should be made by the council.
- It was mentioned that help is now needed every Sunday at the parish School parking lot to help mark spots for the outdoor services. Volunteers should arrive by 0730.

- It was mentioned that the Supreme Council has asked that all council meetings be conducted through zoom until further notice.
- The annual parish festival has been canceled due to the current pandemic.
- It was mentioned that the Financial Secretary needs to be present at all the council meetings therefore it was decided that current Financial Secretary Martin Lobatos should be replaced by brother Bob DeMaggio, and therefore Brother Roger Roe would take his position as a Trustee.
