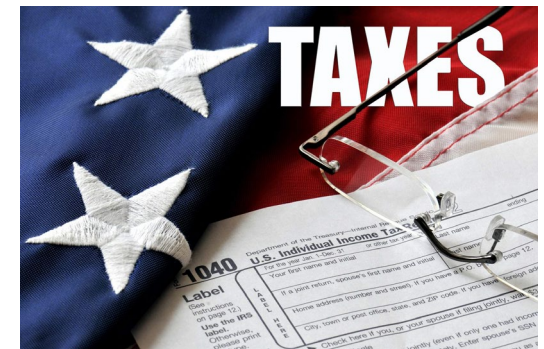
Additional Virtual Appointment Requirements

VITA Program

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax assistance to people who generally make \$57,000 or less, persons with disabilities, seniors, and limited English speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns. IRS-certified volunteers provide free income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals.

Required Documentation

You will be required to present the following documents at your meeting:

1. Proof of Identification (Picture I.D.)
2. Social Security Cards or ITINs for you, your spouse, and your dependents (for married filing joint, both spouses should be present)
3. Tax Forms such as W-2, Forms 1099, and proof of health coverage 1095 (A, B or C), etc.
4. SSN Verification Letter issued by the Social Security Administration or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number
5. If you have been a victim of identity theft, bring your Identity Protection Pin # from the IRS.
6. For direct deposit of refund, proof of account and routing numbers.
7. **See back for additional requirements ONLY if your appointment is virtual.**
