The Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) Schedule for January and February 2018 is attached. It includes all weekend Liturgies from January 6, 2018 through February 25, 2018. It also includes the Liturgies for Ash Wednesday on February 14, 2018.

If you experience any conflicts with the schedule please attempt to find a replacement or contact the Mass Captain (indicated by an asterisk * on the schedule for that Liturgy). Please communicate directly with your Mass Captain on changes to the published schedule. Please do not write “Needs Substitute” on the sign-in roster and expect that the Mass Captain will resolve the problem.

Ministers who are not scheduled to serve at the Liturgy that they are attending, but are properly prepared, should check in the Sacristy with the Mass Captain to see if they are needed to serve as a substitute.

***There are vacancies listed on the schedule for Ash Wednesday. Please consider volunteering to serve if you are attending one of these liturgies. Please send us an e-mail and add your name to the blank space in the Sign-In Book which will be available in the Sacristy.



“Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. The ashes we receive on our forehead in the shape of a cross serve as an outward sign of our sinfulness and need for penance. The ashes symbolize our mortality, a reminder that one day we will die and our bodies will return to dust. Hence the traditional words, “Remember that thou art dust and unto dust thou shalt return.”

“The tradition of receiving ashes has its origins in the Old Testament, where sinners performed acts of public penance. It was Pope Urban II who in the 11th century recommended that all Catholics take part in the practice of receiving ashes on Ash Wednesday. In the 12th century it became customary that the ashes used on Ash Wednesday were made by burning the previous year’s palm branches.”

Good Health Practices for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

With the onset of the cold and flu season the Diocesan Office of Worship offers to all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion the following reminders on good health practices and the administration of the Communion cup at Mass.

PREVENTING THE FLU – Take Care of Yourself

Common sense is most important for the prevention of a cold or the flu. The following health precautions are strongly recommended to limit your risk of infection.

Get vaccinated. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends the flu vaccination, especially for those who are at high risk: young children, pregnant women, people with chronic health conditions & the elderly.

Stay home when sick. There is no sin if you miss Mass because you are sick or taking care of someone who is sick.

Cover your mouth and nose. When you cough or sneeze, use a tissue and throw the tissue in the trash after you use it (or use your sleeve if a tissue is not available).

Wash your hands often. Clean your hands regularly with soap and water, especially after coughing or sneezing. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.

Avoiding touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way.

Stay home an additional 24 hours. If you are sick with flu-like symptoms, the CDC recommends that you stay home for an additional 24 hours after your fever is gone without the use of a fever-reducing medication.

Limit contact with others while sick. If you are feeling sick or you are at risk for infection you should refrain from the Communion cup and perhaps shaking people’s hands at the sign of peace. (If someone chooses to refrain from the handshake, be gracious and considerate.)

ADMINISTERING THE COMMUNION CUP - Reminders

Even though the reception of the Precious Blood from the Communion cup is a much fuller sign of the Eucharistic banquet, the choice to receive from the cup is left to the individual communicant. The CDC has indicated that if the above mentioned preventative health habits are followed and all ministers of Holy Communion are cognizant of the reminders below the chances for infection are greatly diminished.

Stay home when you are sick. Find a replacement.

Wash your hands. Wash your hands before Mass or use an alcohol based anti-bacterial solution or wipe before distributing Holy Communion. Wipes are available in the Ministry Sacristy.

Use all of the purificator. Open the purificator fully and use a clean portion of the purificator to wipe the inside and outside rims of the cup after each communicant has received.

Turn the Cup. Give the cup a ¼ turn before presenting it to the next communicant.

May God, Our Father, bless us with a joyful and healthy Christmas and New Year 2018.

Ash Wednesday

The Liturgical Ministry for Ministers of the Bread for Ash Wednesday also includes the distribution of ashes. Ministers of the Cup will distribute ashes when specifically identified by the Mass Captain. Please sign-in prior to Mass and check with the Mass Captain as assigned stations and duties may change from those published below.

Ashes will be blessed and distributed immediately after the Homily. Ministers distributing ashes will immediately precede at this time to the center aisle as in the distribution of Holy Communion, receive ashes from the priest, pick up their dish of ashes from the table near the altar, and proceed to their assigned station. Following the distribution of ashes, ministers will return the dish to the table near the altar and proceed to the wash bowl located on the choir side of the altar. Water, soap and towels will be available for the cleaning of your hands in preparation for the distribution of Holy Communion. Return to your seat after cleansing your hands for the continuation of the Ash Wednesday liturgy. Procedures for the distribution of Holy Communion will be the same as the weekend liturgies.

Ashes are placed on each individual forehead in the sign of a cross, while either of the following verses is recited. Please do not distribute ashes to infants. Please serve at the assigned station; unless common sense dictates otherwise. Let us pray for and with each other during this special time of God's Grace.

1. Remember you are dust and into dust you will return.
2. Turn from sin and return to the Gospel.
