Introduction

The Diocese of Buffalo is at a pivotal point in its long history as the predominant faith community in our region. We have an opportunity to emerge from the cloud that has been created by a loss of trust due to abuse cases and failures of past leadership. Recognizing constraints in financial resources, in 2020 the Diocese curtailed multiple ministries and filed for Chapter 11 Reorganization. Together, these events, coupled with overall societal views of religion and the pandemic, have led to a tremendous loss in the number of parishioners, particularly among the young.

Bishop Michael Fisher took on the role as Shepherd of this Diocese in January 2021 and embraced the planning underway to renew parish life. The plan was developed following rich input gathered in partnership with the Movement to Restore Trust and in listening sessions held for each Vicariate and responds to the trends of declining engagement, fewer priests, and an over-abundance of facilities. The Diocesan-wide "Road to Renewal" journey began two years ago and continues to reorganize our parishes into thirty-six "Families" of three to six parishes with one pastor for each Family. Further input to Diocesan planning was gathered during the 2022 Synod sessions: Listening in Love and Hope, Conversations about Church.

Bishop Mike has also asked that a broader plan to encompass additional areas of Diocesan life be prepared. He led this effort through articulating important goals for his ministry here in Buffalo:

- instill a sense of hope and renew faith,
- restore trust,
- develop leadership,
- align all around a common strategy, and lastly,
- deepen our commitment to share our talents within our community and to serve those in need.

GOAL 2: Forming Catholics

2A: Faith Formation

Maximize opportunity of new Family of Parishes and Vicariate Structure to redesign:

- Faith Formation (including youth, adult and family faith formation, sacramental preparation, Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)
- Cultivate new strategies for adult formation

2B: Catholic Schools

- Develop sustainable plan to deliver excellence in both secular academics and Catholic formation for parochial and regional K-8 schools
- Evaluate ability to coordinate Pre-School Education as means for earlier initiation and engagement for Catholic formation for both child and parents.
- Strengthen Catholic identity at affiliated K-8 schools, high schools, colleges, and universities.



2C: Clergy Education & Development

- Establish comprehensive plan for Priestly and Diaconate:
 - o formation
 - continuing education
 - on-going spiritual direction
 - Inculturation for extern priests

- o Strengthening of homiletics
- Identify opportunities to transition functions to laity

2D: Staff & Volunteer Development

- Establish a comprehensive plan for orientation, spiritual development, job skills, and resource training to meet the needs of Central Administrative Offices (Catholic Center), Vicariate, and Families of Parishes staffs
- Identify opportunities and provide training for lay volunteers and staff to assume expanded responsibilities allowing clergy to maximize spiritual and sacramental ministry

2E: Safe Environment

 On-going education and assessment of practices to ensure we provide a safe environment and to restore trust

GOAL 3: Optimizing Financial Resources

- Complete Reorganization: Chapter 11, including restitution for survivors of abuse
- Develop on-going financial plan for Catholic Center and funding models for shared expenses in Vicariates and Families of Parishes
 - Respond to the reality of decreasing offertory collections
 - Identify programs for alternate funding sources
 - Clarify need/opportunity for recruiting volunteers to new or expanded roles
 - Develop comprehensive property management plan
 - Address cemetery perpetual funding



GOAL 4: Accountability

- Reorganize operations to Maximize Efficiency
 - Prioritize functions structures, processes, and committees for opportunities to streamline, economize, and automate where practical
 - o Migrate all Diocesan entities to a single payroll system, health plan, etc.
 - Develop consistent Job Descriptions, interviewing procedures, and skill sets needed for defined roles
- Renew effective governance for all Diocesan entities
 - O Develop definable, measurable goals
 - o Establish milestone "check-ins" to review progress

GOAL 5: Enlarge Our Tent

Provide or enhance ministry and leadership roles to those previously disenfranchised or underrepresented.
