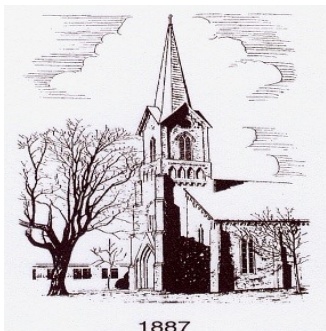

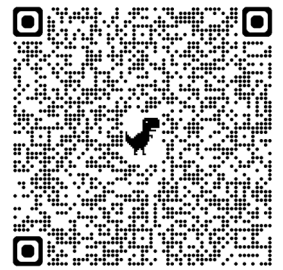
We are so excited to share that Vacation Bible School is coming June 8–12, and this year's theme is "Come to the Table!"
