We will still continue follow all the guidelines we are given:

- * Those who are 65 and over and those who have any health issues are recommended to stay at home and attend the Mass online, if they can.
- * Only 50% of the seating capacity of church could be filled. If there are more people than we could accommodate in the church, please make use of our School Cafeteria and attend the Mass using TV screen there.
- * Those who come to the church, please keep the distance of six feet, especially when you come for the communion, and always **WEAR THE MASK**.
- * When you come, the Missalette you use, please take home (one for one family), and bring it back to the church, for your personal use, every time you come.
- * The family members who live in the same house, can stay together in the church. If one pew is fully occupied by family, leave the pew behind unoccupied to leave a space of six feet!
- * Those who come for Communion, please keep the distance of 6 feet between the communicant, and please receive the Communion in your hand.
- * Remember, for those who are not able to attend the Mass in the church or online, Bishop Spalding has already granted the dispensation from the Sunday Obligation up to **Monday, August 03rd!**

known that St. Thomas preached the Gospel in Asia beyond the frontiers of the Roman Empire, probably in Persia and possibly as far afield as India. St. Thomas' feast was formerly celebrated on December 21.

First Saturday Rosary and Mass

The Five First Saturdays Devotion is a request made by Our Lady of Fatima. The Blessed Mother promised to assist at the hour of death with the graces necessary for salvation all who, as an act of reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, on the first five Saturdays of consecutive months:

- Go to confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- Say five decades of the rosary
- Keep Mary company for fifteen minutes meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the rosary

The sacramental confession can be received within eight days either before or after the reception of Communion, provided the communicant is in a state of grace for Communion.

Reception of Holy Communion must take place within twenty-four hours of the first Saturday. The reception of Communion need not be part of a Mass.

Sacred Heart Church will begin to have First Saturday Mass at 9:00 am preceded by Adoration at 8:00 am.

The Lawrence County Business & Professional Women is celebrating its 50th year in our county. On July 8, 2020 at 10 am, we will mark our anniversary by having a bridge dedicated to Sacred Heart parishioners Anna & Sophia Beuerlein. Anna & Sophia are buried in Calvary Cemetery. Both were nurses in the Army Nursing Corp and served in WW II and the Korean War, attaining the rank of captain. It is the only bridge in this county dedicated to women. Relatives of Anna & Sophia, friends of the family, and interested parties are cordially invited to attend. The bridge is located on Fall River Road.



St. Junipero Serra - July 1

Miguel Jose Serra was born on the island of Mallorca, Spain. He took the name Junipero when he entered the Franciscan Order in 1730. Ordained in 1737, he taught philosophy and theology at the University of Padua for twelve years. At age 37, he went to Mexico City where he spent the rest of his life working for the conversion of the peoples of the New World. Largely responsible for the spread of the Church on the West Coast of the United States, Junipero founded 21 missions and converted thousands of Native Americans.

Saints Peter & Paul, Apostles - June 29

Veneration of the two great Apostles, Peter and Paul, has its roots in the very foundations of the Church. They are the solid rock on which the Church is built. They are at the origin of her faith and will forever remain her protectors and her guides. To them Rome owes her true greatness, for it was under God's providential guidance that they were led to make the capital of the Empire, sanctified by their martyrdom, the center of the Christian world whence should radiate the preaching of the Gospel.

St. Peter suffered martyrdom under Nero, in A.D. 66 or 67. He was buried on the hill of the Vatican where recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the Basilica of St. Peter's. St. Paul was beheaded in the Via Ostia on the spot where now stands the basilica bearing his name. Down the centuries Christian people in their thousands have gone on pilgrimage to the tombs of these Apostles. In the second and third centuries the Roman Church already stood pre-eminent by reason of her apostolicity, the infallible truth of her teaching and her two great figures, Sts. Peter and Paul.

A partial indulgence may be gained today by anyone who makes devout use of a religious article blessed by any priest but "if the article of devotion has been blessed by the Sovereign Pontiff or by any Bishop, the faithful, using it, can also gain a plenary indulgence, provided they also make a profession of faith (e.g. the Apostles Creed), as long as the usual conditions are satisfied.


