Advertisement Space Available

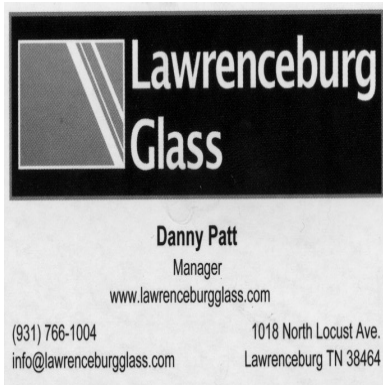
We have space available for anyone who would like to put an advertisement for their business in our Church bulletin.
