

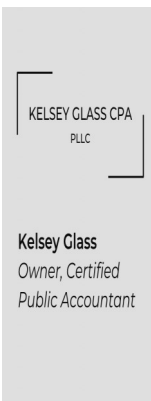
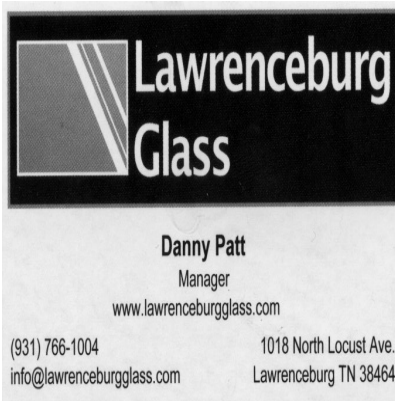
Advertisement Space Available
