

Advertisement Space Available

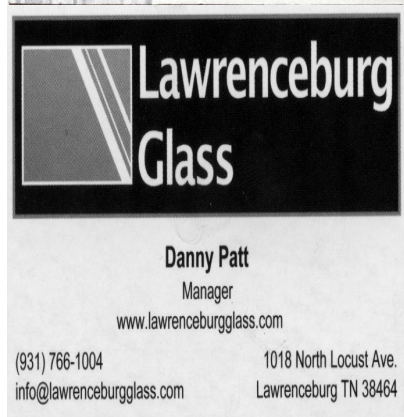

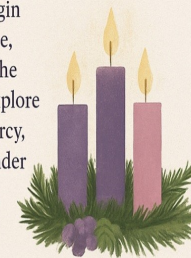
