

Advertisement Space Available

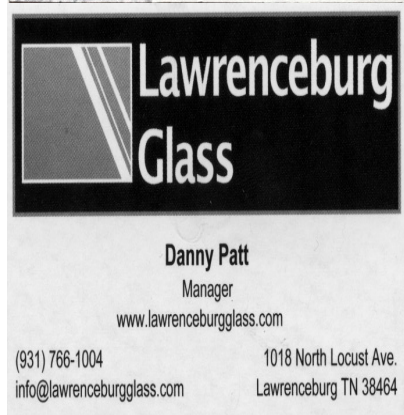

Sacred Heart Church Annual Christmas Potluck & Bingo

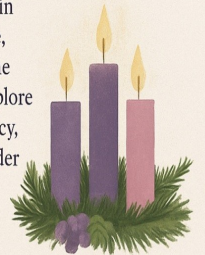
