- Do I share what I have with them?
- Do I respect other people's property?
- Am I truthful and honest in my dealings with others?
- Do I judge others? Do I spread gossip about others?
- Am I inclined to blame others when something goes wrong?
- Do I sin against purity in mind or action?
- Am I a committed follower of Jesus Christ?
