

Fast Facts About Our Sister Diocese Mission Programs

YEARS OF IMPACT

- Just since 2013 we have supported 100 mission trips with 2,089 missionaries/volunteers
- Most recently over 170 construction, educational, pastoral, medical missionaries and local volunteers have given more than 10,000 hours of their time annually

LATEST FACTS

- We currently support 440 students in Pre-K through 8th grade in our four mission schools and 37 students in our residential high school program in our Sister Diocese
- Three Dominican students graduated from Florida Catholic schools and two graduated from U.S. universities this year
- Five Dominican students are currently attending U.S. Catholic schools and two are attending U.S. universities
- We are currently building 41 houses in La Cueva
- We are currently working on a multi-community water project where approximately 1,100 households are going to have direct access to clean water.
- We are currently finishing up a covered multi-purpose court in Los Frios, thanks to grants from the Japanese Embassy and the Ruckstuhl Foundation.
- Parishioners and friends donate multiple shipping containers worth of clothes, household supplies, and other essentials. Included last year were 1,310 jars of peanut butter and 640 tennis shoes!

A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY

- \$25 a month gives families clean filtered water
- \$35 a month supports a child in school
- \$150 a month provides breakfast, lunch and dinner for a growing teenage student in our Residence Program.
- \$750 sends a volunteer on an education, construction or medical mission. This covers lodging, food, insurance, and ground transportation in the DR.
