- Meeting in Social Hall was called to order at 6:42pm and an opening prayer was said by Fr Pat.
- Sept Minutes were approved; Michael 1<sup>st</sup>, Pat 2<sup>nd</sup>. No meeting was held in October due to Fr Pat's traveling schedule. No meeting was held in November due to too many absences with illnesses, etc.
- Sanctuary Project Update Subcommittee members (Joe, Michael, Buster)
  - Les Wicker, a talented stained-glass artist, designed some renditions of stained glass that could be added to the rectangular windows in the sanctuary and how the brick wall could be "beautified" with paint
  - Buster presented a survey sheet with many ideas that the council members prioritized
- "Pink House"/Adoration Chapel Name Rick
  - Consensus that area would be called "St. Eugene's Adoration Chapel"/"La Capilla de Adoracion de San Eugenio"; motioned by Michael, second by Joe; passed
- Ministry Fair Recap General Discussion
  - Awareness campaign was a success; tough weekend with co-celebration of Confirmation, but did bring ministry awareness to the youth that were being confirmed so they can get involved.
  - Ed suggested that after the holidays, maybe during Lenten season, could re-present when people are less busy/overwhelmed to get more responses to the call for help
  - Continuing presentation; placing banners up all year in Social Hall w/info about ministry and contact info
    of leader to call if want to volunteer
  - Generational differences: how to present to and involve the younger generations? Keeping website up-to-date; links to Facebook page for each ministry?
  - Coffee/donuts starting up in January after 9am; cookies/juice after 5pm Mass; so if banners were up by that time would help. Currently, due to traffic congestion, cannot have a social event after 7:30am Mass.
- Six Commission Assignments General Discussion
  - Smaller, more permanent assignments of parishioners that report to MaryEllen and Fr Pat and have more direct control and knowledge of the commission and the ministries under its purview
- Parking Congestion between 7:30/9:00 Masses Fr Pat
  - Suggestion to try blocking off the angled parking at ACS so traffic can flow better on Culvern.
  - Requesting on heavily attended weekends that people park at SteinMart or other parking lots and make a "pilgrimage" across the street
  - Changing Mass times, possibly 7:15-8:15 and 9:15-10:15 with CCD 10:15-11:00?
- Security Incident Rick
  - About 3wks ago on a Sunday, after the 11:30 Mass, a parishioner's four tires were slashed in the parking lot behind the church that belongs to another business; reported to police
- Suggestion Box Shawna
  - All were read and discussed and passed on to appropriate members to "deal with" and contact the people that wrote the suggestions
  - Request that USCCB Prayers of the Faithful be used during Respect Life month (Oct). Laurie made a motion for those petitions to be used. Rick asked Fr Pat if he would just agree to do so and Fr Pat agreed, so no motion was made.

- New/Other Business or Upcoming Events
  - Bears/trash cans; new location, new cans, new shed to lock them in? going to ask Salvador to look into
  - James noted that Fr Doug announced people outside the church are begging after Mass; church's position is to direct these people to Catholic Charities or St Vincent de Paul for crisis assistance.
     Can publish the card in the bulletin with the organizations/contact info to hand out (see below).
     Rick noted county number is "211" and they can refer to all these other organizations.
- Closing Prayer was said by Fr Pat and meeting was adjourned at 8:15p.
