- Walking With Moms In Need Karen Bradley/Mary Head
 - Started last spring; program of US program of Bishops (Committee of Pro Life activities)
 - Parenting/pregnant moms in need can turn to the parish community, helps parishes refer and support moms
 - 5 phases of the program (1. Core team assembly 2. Inventory of resources/centers in community, where gaps exist 3. identify and assess how to meet needs, 4. Share with and communicate to parish)
 - Priority of prayer, weekly mass intentions, members of parish to pray for program/people/life, educate parish where to refer moms in need, enlist more members
 - Mentoring process of parents
 - Collect diapers/wipes for donation
 - Provide info about volunteer opportunities
 - Ask for support for material/financial support from the parish council
- St. Eugene Parish Eucharistic Renewal Fr. Pat
 - Three-year focus; 1st year was diocesan (Eucharistic congress), 2nd year is parish renewal; 3rd year is the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis
 - Council members shared thoughts
 - How do we educate and renew for the individual what is the Eucharist, the liturgy about the Eucharist
 - Plans: display of Eucharistic miracles in our parish hall (80 displays, three weekends in September, three weekends in October); public adoration chapel for private devotion; personal conversions and active full participation of the members of the parish; come to a daily life experience/reality
 - Could the renovation of the sanctuary help return focus to the Eucharist? New furniture coming from closing church in Maine
 - Youth Mass (Monday nights); youth catechesis and relevance, age-appropriate materials
 - Digital messaging, social media; lists of resources to get closer to the Eucharist
 - Continuing Ed w/Dcn John
 - Fr Pat wants this to be THE theme of Parish Council this 2023-2024 year
- Update on potential new Parish Discussion Group James Greene
 - Inspired by Synod talks, wanted to be able to ask tough questions and really talk about it, a type of catharsis
 - Still need a consensus for meeting times
- Lector training for Youth minsters Rick
 - Working w/Raul Cervantes, made announcements at Sunday 7am mass, seeking interested youth to get them more involved in the liturgy of the Mass
 - Working with Guadelupe (new religious education minister) to reach out with Faith Formation to find more interested youth

- Suggestion Box Shawna
 - A thank you to Fr Pagel for his homilies and care when he is at our parish
 - Concern about grounds, weeds; offer to donate for a pizza party if youth interested in a grounds-keeping day (Work day is scheduled)
- Other Business or Upcoming events
 - Fr Pat is going to start UNCA Mass in August on the 27th at 6pm, (will be every last Sunday of month, Highsmith Center, Lookout Rm); parishioners are welcome, pizza will be served after mass; Carlton Smith is heading up help at UNCA (Aug Apr, skipping December)
