Parish Council Information/Interest Form

Parish Council Role: The 12-member Parish Council (not including the Pastor) is an advisory body of parishioners who provide overall pastoral leadership and resources to our pastor for the overall life of our parish. The Council facilitates communication among the pastor, parishioners and the diocese to promote the parish's mission.

Nomination, Selection & Responsibilities: Each year four Parish Council members complete their 3-year assignment and four new parishioners are recruited by April 30th by Parish Council members via the Parish bulletin. The new Council members are chosen in May after discussing interest and eligibility with the candidate(s). Per the bylaws, parishioners eligible to serve on the Parish Council must:

1. Consent to a background check
2. Complete Protecting God's Children Program
3. Be registered and in good standing with the Church
4. Participate in parish life
5. Commit to a three-year assignment and give the time needed
6. Commit to attend every meeting and be prepared to lead in some parish activity

The Pastor and the Council will recommend and select a nominee by majority vote, with final approval by the Pastor. The Pastor will contact the newly selected members and alternates. Parish Council members will contact each nominee not chosen.
