EVERYTHING WE HAVE IS A GIFT FROM GOD.


Stewardship, quite simply, is recognizing that everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God.

2022-23 FINANCES AT HOLY FAMILY

Our parish incurred expenses in 2022-23 for much-needed repairs to the elevator and the rectory driveway, along with rectory renovations to prepare for the arrival of our new pastor.

With support from Holy Family parish groups and individuals, more than \$85,000 was raised to help cover these costs.

*Holy Family contributed \$33,500 for second collections to benefit ministries in our diocese and around the world. These funds go directly to these ministries and are not included above.

How much should you share in 2023-24? Holy Family anticipates it will need \$1,881,400 in total giving to adequately fund our parish ministries and operations.
