Dear St. Mark Family,

More marvelous stories this week! First, a man finds a treasure in a field, and then buries it again. Why does he do that? He sells all of his possessions to buy the field and rejoices at his good fortune. What would you do?

Most of us would consider it "Finders Keepers" and take the treasure and run. But what is this treasure this man is willing to give up everything he owns? The word of God, the Kingdom of the poor, the presence of the Risen Lord, and the power of the Holy Spirit—all of these. He cannot just take the buried treasure however, but must also have the community (the field) and share his treasure with them. Nothing else matters as it brings such joy to share the Kingdom of God with others.

In the second parable of the pearl of great value, the merchant sells all that he has to purchase the valuable pearl (Kingdom of God). He gives to the poor as he stores up his treasure in heaven. Again, what would you do with the pearl? Perhaps make a ring or find other pearls to string together a neck-

lace (all the stories of God strung together—WOW). Or would you sell it again and bring joy to the poor.

These meanings are just the first layer of the message. Dig and look; don't just take for yourself but share the word with others and find the treasure given to them. And, of course, Rejoice in the Lord Always.

Vacation Bible School was a great success. We had over 200 participants in the program. Special thanks go to Sharon Buquoi, Jessica Kehn, and all those who helped them with this project. Parents, thank you. Boys and girls, your enthusiasm to learn and proclaim the Good News is truly contagious, and it is amazing to witness your great joy. 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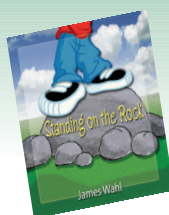
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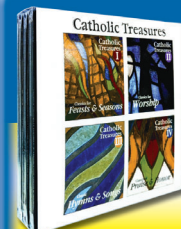
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
