PSR Class Guidelines/Expectations.....Refer to the St. Mark Catholic Church PSR Handbook, 2019-2020 to answer the following questions. This handbook is posted on the St. Mark Facebook page and parish website www.stmarkgonzales.org It was handed out to your parents at a recent meeting. You can also pick one up from the church office.

1. What is the date of the second PSR class?
2. What time does class start?
3. If you wish to eat the snack that has been prepared, we ask that you arrive between 5:45 and 6:00 so that you have enough time to eat. Can you remember to do this?
4. What is the date of the high school retreat (not the 11th grade Confirmation retreat)?
5. If you miss a class, you are expected to complete makeup/home work. Read the information below and answer the questions about it.

8. The new dismissal/pickup procedure was explained. A note was handed out to all parents who dropped their teens off and to those teens who drive to PSR. Read the note below and answer the questions about it.

New Dismissal/Pickup Procedure

Park only in the main church parking lot.

The lot by the office/grotto is for teachers ONLY.

Please do NOT make lines/line up.

Students will be dismissed at 8:30 PM and go directly to their cars.

Please exit the parking lot SLOWLY as soon as you have your teen.

Thanks so much for your cooperation! Your teen's safety is our first concern!

- c) What time will all students exit the buildings for dismissal?
- d) When can students leave the parking lot?
- e) How should everyone leave the parking lot at dismissal?
- f) Why is this procedure so important?

10. Can you bring your phone into PSR class?
11. When are you allowed to use your phone?
12. If you do not follow the cell phone rule, what will happen to your phone?
13. When are parish penance services held?
14. How many retreats do you need to attend?
15. How many total service hours do you need to complete?
16. What is the time of the high school retreat on 10/27/19?
17. No outside food and/or drink may be brought into PSR class. Can you remember to follow this?

3. Who can be your sponsor for Confirmation?
4. True or False.....One of your parents can be your sponsor.
5. When choosing and writing your saint report, what is the best resource?
6. How long does your Saint report need to be?
7. Besides providing information about the saint that you choose, what important question should be answered in your report?
8. How many service hours should you complete?
9. Why should you do service hours?
10. How do you record your service hours?

7. What is one example of a visible reality that points to an invisible one?
8. Who said “know thyself”?
9. Why would St. John Paul II say it is so important to “know thyself”?
10. Read the inspiring words of St. John Paul II at the end of the sixth page.
What was he encouraging young people to do?

Read the last two pages of the attached material and answer the following questions:

1. Why were so many young people captivated by St. John Paul II?
2. Describe the hardships that St. John Paul II had to face as a young person.
3. How many countries did St. John Paul II travel to after he was elected pope?
4. How many speeches did St. John Paul II deliver during his first five years of his papacy?
5. What did these lectures become known as?
6. St. John Paul II told the youth in Poland, “We are often tempted not to enter the depth of our own conscience; let us reject this immediately and proceed into the depth.” Explain what this quote means to you.
