When the Rwandan Genocide began in 1994, Immaculée's father sent her to hide in the home of a local pastor. Huddled in a 3x4 bathroom while with seven other women for three months, they were unable to speak to each other lest they be heard and they had to take turns standing up in the cramped space. Turning to prayer to escape the anger, resentment and hate that was building up within her, Immaculée found a peace, hope and faith so profound that after the destruction she was able to face the man who killed her mother and brother and forgive him. More than just a talk on Immaculée's experiences, this weekend offers an opportunity for all to seek hope, peace and forgiveness.
