Approval of Minutes – November 2021 minutes Teresa Dorshorst motioned, Ray Farley seconded. The minutes were approved.

Comments from Sacred Heart – Teresa Dorshorst reported. The January meeting was cancelled. The gym is open for rentals, and the portico process is moving along.

Welcome School Board Representative

- 1. School Board Report John Adams summarized the School Board report, and provided the following updates:
 - ICS Open House Jan. 30 this has been scaled back this year due to Covid
 - Newly launched Gibault tutoring program
 - All activities will go through Team Snap. Athletics Committee may be renamed to include all activities, not just sports.
 - Pre-K and Pre-school schedule changes being incorporated for next school year
 - New Student Enrollment Policy being simplified
- 2. Principal's Report Dave Gregson reported:
 - New large projection screen has been donated and a new projector purchased with funds from the Father's Club
 - New hallway murals sponsored by Parents and Friends/Father's Club
 - New fishing club; chess and golf clubs being looked into
 - New COVID policy; 5-day quarantine instead of 10; on return, there is full masking and separation when unmasking is needed
 - Catholic Schools Week begins Jan. 30. Parents invited to all-school Mass on 2/3
 - Students making blessing bags to distribute to places in need

Staff Reports

- 1. Pastor's Report Fr. Carl Scherrer reported:
 - ACTS retreat weekend of Jan.29 16 retreatants
 - CSMA had 244 donors, reached financial goal. Campaign for 2022 starting up week before Lent
 - Search committee has been assembled to find business manager replacement following Keith Huels resignation. The hope is to have someone in place by April 1 so they can shadow Keith.
 - Bishop has invited parishes to have "listening sessions" between Feb-May leading up to Synod
 - Msgr. James Margason, former diocesan Vicar General has passed away
 - Quinceañera celebration for parishioner coming up Feb. 12, 5 p.m. Mass
 - Mike and Jeanne Kish scholarship established at Gibault
- 2. Liturgy & Music Report Fr. Nick Fleming reported:
 - He will be visiting various diocesan schools during Catholic Schools Week
 - Gibault will be potentially having a revamp of Theology curriculum, which might be able to be lined up with our grade school and PSR
 - Looking for potential leaders from parish youth to help lead youth group. Exploring Word on Fire: Engage as parish app
- 3. Director of Faith Formation Lizanne Young reported:
 - Using Zoom to facilitate parent meetings
 - 12 inquirers for RCIA
 - Women's Book/Bible Study going well
 - Opportunity to host a viewing of "The Reluctant Convert" film about C. S. Lewis
- 4. Finance Report Lizanne Young presented highlights from Keith Huels' finance report:
 - Diocese agreed to refinance unsold bonds down from 5.5 to 3 percent
 - The planned giving committee launched the Guardian Angel Society
 - Diocese is requiring ICS to convert from OptionC to FACTS school management system for the next school year.

Old Business

- 1. Update on pictorial directory Hope Wienhoff will be staffing a signup table weekend of Jan. 29. Need to encourage folks to sign up
- 2. Stewardship of Charity update nominations until Feb. 7; voting starts Feb. 20
- 3. Pastoral Council Constitution discussion Article IV & V
