Schedule

Preschool, Kindergarten, and 1st grade meet during the 10 am Mass beginning September 14.

<u>2nd through 5th grade</u> have monthly family catechism meetings. Parents and children meet together for the first 30 minutes and then the children go to their classrooms and parents meet with Becky for an adult faith presentation. The time choices will be Saturday- 9:30 am, Sunday- 4 pm, or Tuesday- 6 pm beginning September 13, 14, 16.

<u>6th through 8th grade meet after 10 am Mass beginning September 14.</u> This is a parent/student meeting with food included to kick off our program for the year.

8th graders are invited to prepare for Confirmation. They will be Confirmed early in their 9th grade year. We do not have the exact date yet, but historically it was in October. If you have a high schooler that has not been Confirmed and would like to prepare please contact Becky Keiser to discuss the best option for your young person. We will have the Confirmation orientation meeting after 10 am Mass October 5th in the Knights of Columbus room.
