

Faith Formation Youth Assistants

Being a Youth Assistant in a Faith Formation class is a ministry opportunity for high school students to share and model the love of Jesus with students in grades K-5. Like adult catechists, youth assistants are role models conscious of their words, actions and attitudes, making sure their example points to Jesus. Youth Assistants are a cooperative, supportive, active, prayerful, and an integral part of a small group teaching team.

Class Times

Weekly Mass Attendance

- Helping in a class does not take the place of receiving the Eucharist at Mass. (Those helping with Little Shepherds will need to make sure you attend Mass at a different time.)

Additional Expectations

- Follow the catechist's instructions - you might be helping with a small group of children one week and making copies the next
- Participate in class prayer
- Arrive on time
- Encourage the children to participate
- Help to provide a safe and welcoming place for the students to grow and learn about Jesus
