There are only a few, but are very important. If you have issues with any of them please contact me or the office so we can help you better understand their intent.

1. If you host a trunk you are not allowed to take pictures of the kids that visit you. It is OK for family members of the children attending to take them. This is from the office.
2. Only pass out store bought/wrapped candy. Homemade treats are hard for the kids to handle and parents do not always trust them no matter where they came from.
3. Make certain your trunks and decorations are kid safe.

We will provide as much candy as we can to keep things going. We will have some Boy Scouts going around to help fill your buckets. When it's gone we are done. You can start setting up your trunk at 5:30pm.
