

Teacher In-Service: In late August, our school and parish staff participated in ALICE training which focused on procedures in schools during active shooter situations. It was very worthwhile to go through this training and better adapt our procedures to keep the children safe in our school. The next phase of the training deals with assisting any wounded individuals if a shooting were ever to occur at school. The trainers emphasized that emergency personnel will not be allowed in the building until the shooter is apprehended. Therefore, the staff are the ones who need to be trained to help those who are wounded. On Wednesday, October 31st, our teachers and staff will receive this training in the afternoon and will dismiss all students at 10:30 that morning. We have already moved hot lunch on that day to Tuesday. Also, Just Like Home will take their regularly scheduled students early that day. Walled Lake will also provide bus service at 10:30 for all students who normally ride the bus. We don't usually have ½ day dismissals, but we feel that this is a critical training that needs to be completed by our staff. We hope that the advance notice will assist you in helping us take this afternoon.
