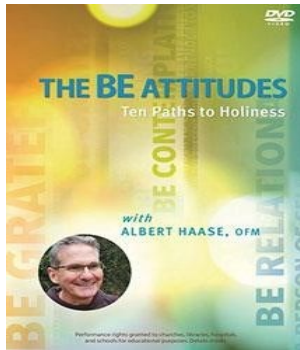


The Be Attitudes: Ten Paths to Holiness
