INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A LACK OF FORM CASE

It is the responsibility of the petitioner to provide all supportive documentation and funding along with the petition. The Tribunal requires:

- 1) A recent baptismal certificate of the Catholic party(ies). If both parties are baptized Catholic, copies of both baptism certificates should be submitted with the application. This record must have been issued within the last six (6) months and must indicate in writing whatever notations are found regarding any previous marriage or state "NO NOTATION." This notation must be issued from the church of baptism.
- 2) Two affidavits of corroboration. The petitioner must provide witnesses who can verify that the marriage in question was never validated or "blessed" according to Catholic Church law (Use attached affidavit form). Normally, the witnesses would be immediate family members. The two affidavits **MUST** bear a parish or notary seal.
- 3) A civil marriage record. Only original or certified, seal-bearing copy can be accepted (c.1544).
- 4) A final decree of divorce. The petitioner must include complete civil documentation of the divorce. If there is a mention of a merged or incorporated document in the final decree, this document must also be submitted. Again, only original or certified, seal-bearing copies can be accepted (c.1544).
- 5) The complete, current address for the respondent (former spouse). The respondent may be contacted.
- 6) The petitioner must include a check to the Diocese of Charleston in the amount of \$20 to defray office expenses.
- 7) The questionnaire and all documentation must be submitted through a case assistant (the priest, deacon, or other person at your local parish assigned to work with petitioners). The case assistant is responsible for going over the form with you, witnessing your signature after you take the oath, and then mailing your questionnaire and documentation to the Tribunal Office. You are encouraged to make copies of these materials for your personal files and call the Tribunal Office after about two weeks to be sure your case materials have been received.

DIOCESE OF CHARLESTON PETITION FOR A DECREE OF LACK OF CANONICAL FORM

This petition is intended for the use of marriages in which one party, at least, was a Catholic and who entered marriage without fulfilling the requirement of canonical form, and who now wishes to enter a new marriage in the Catholic Church. Catholic law requires a Catholic to contract marriage before the local ordinary, pastor, or a priest or deacon delegated by either of them unless previously dispensed from this obligation by the Diocesan bishop (cf. canon 1108). For marriages contracted before January 1st, 1949, contact the Tribunal Office for special instructions.

Agreement of understanding

- I, the undersigned petitioner, understand the following points with regard to my petition for a decree of invalidity.
- 1. I understand that if the Tribunal accepts my case for consideration, it cannot and does not guarantee that the case will be processed as a lack of form case and that an Affirmative decision will be given in the case.
- 2. Because case types sometimes change once the Tribunal reviews all of the case information, I understand that the Tribunal recommends that a marriage date not be set until a final Decree of Nullity has been issued.
- 3. I understand that the Tribunal cannot and will not ever guarantee that a case will be concluded by a certain date. Because of this I agree to wait until I receive a final decision in writing from the Tribunal before I set a definite date for marriage within the Catholic Church or convalidation of an existing marriage.
- 4. I understand that I may be asked to assist in obtaining information or documents in the interest of my case, or that it may be necessary for the Tribunal to do this.
- 5. I understand that if the circumstances causing the invalidity of the marriage so indicate, the Tribunal may find it necessary to require that I seek professional counseling before a marriage in the Catholic Church. The counseling will be at the direction of the Tribunal.
- 6. I agree to provide for candor and openness in testimony, in recognition of the purely spiritual and religious nature of these proceedings, and to allow the Tribunal to process this case free from undue entanglements or hindrance, I voluntary waive now and in the future any right under law to subpoena or judicial discovery of the testimonial or documentary acts of the case. This waiver is given without reservation or condition.
- 7. If applicable to my personal situation, I further understand that Church law prohibits me, or my present spouse, completion of the RCIA program unless and until a decree of nullity has been issued for this marriage and all other prior marriages for myself and my present spouse.
