Writer's Workshop: Our class will be having fun writing about their own pet reindeer, how they would help cheer up the Grinch, and letters to Santa Claus.

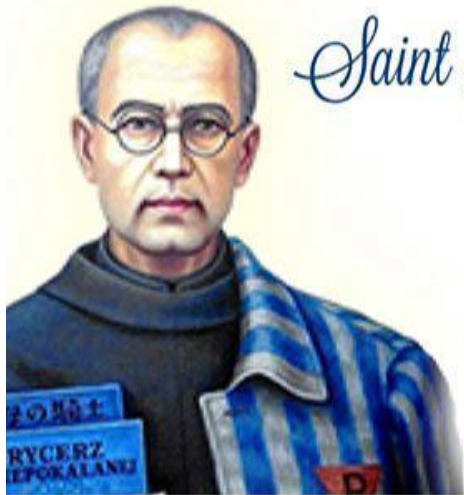
Word Work: The children will continue to identify the "L" blends. They will also learn about the following word families: ip, ap, oss, and ate.
