This week, the students will be preparing to lead the all-school prayer service on Monday and the all-school Liturgy on Wednesday, 9/27/2023. They will also be taking their first religion assessment tomorrow. The students have class notes in their notebooks that they should review as well as reread Chapter 1 in their book, so they feel prepared for the quiz.

During the all-school Liturgy next week, the students will be describing the role that St. Vincent de Paul had on the Catholic Church. They will also be helping the students and staff learn about what the St. Vincent de Paul society does here at St. John the Evangelist. You are welcome to join us in church at 10:00. Please sit in the side sections of pews. The students will take up most of the middle section this year.

If your child would like to become a Junior Lector for our school Masses, please have him/her contact Mr. Courchane for a sign-up sheet. We will work with the students and their reading prior to Mass. We could really use some assistance with this important ministry.

The students have completed their first round of STAR reading and math tests. Mrs. Wisniewski is meeting with each student to evaluate and change their Accelerated Reader goals based on the test results. Many have already finished a book and are ready to take a test and move on to a new book. Reading is such an important life skill. As with all skills, it needs to be practiced if we want to improve. I challenge you to model this skill by sitting down and reading during the same time as your child.

Honor Cards are in full effect and have been staying clean. PLEASE remember to check your child's Honor Card regularly. It is stapled inside the front cover of their assignment notebook, which should come home every afternoon. It is important for your child to hear your comments and expectations before you receive an e-mail or phone call from school because their green Honor Card is filling up.
