Students are finishing their Paper Chain Pixel Art. They will be displayed in the hallway by conference time. Our next project will be fall-focused!

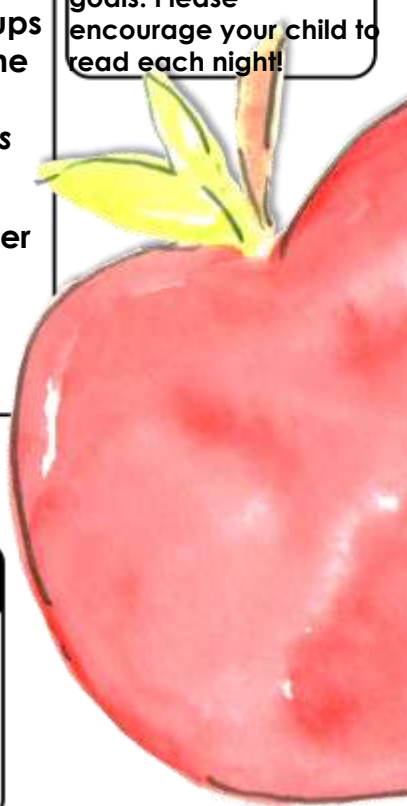


At Home
