St. John the Evangelist Service-Learning Program

St. John the Evangelist School includes a program of required service-learning in keeping with our mission to provide service to the community. The intent of this program is for each student to develop a sense of commitment and responsibility and to gain in personal development. St. John the Evangelist emphasizes service outcomes as primary and learning goals as another essential component. Requirements include five hours of service in fifth grade, five hours of service in sixth grade, ten hours of service in seventh grade, and ten hours of service in the eighth grade, for a cumulative total of 30 hours of service. Students are not expected to complete hours of service if they were not in attendance at St. John the Evangelist. For example, they would only need to complete 20 hours of service if their enrollment began in 7th grade. Each time a student completes a service experience, they MUST turn in this COMPLETED form to Mr. Courchane in a timely manner.
