


Math


This week we continued working on creating patterns and began talking about long/short and more/less. We also continue counting objects to various numbers up to 10. We had fun making Dr. Seuss patterns, Cat in the Hat cup stacking, and counting fish! We continue counting and moving each day.



This week we learned the letter A, reviewed all previously learned letters, and practiced clapping the syllables in words. Each day we review the letters and sounds a different way. Sometimes they are given an uppercase letter and have to find the matching lowercase and sometimes they are given a letter and need to find a picture that has a beginning sound to match a letter. We reviewed finger space in between words, which lets us know when one word ends and another begins. Some books we read this week: "The Cat in the Hat," "One Fish Two Fish Red Fish Blue Fish," "The Foot Book," "The Lorax," and "Green Eggs and Ham."
