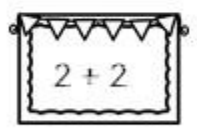

Math

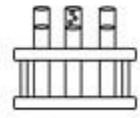


We continue to count out loud and do the correct number of movements. Each day this week we counted objects to 2 and during centers practiced writing the number 2. In centers we had lots of apple fun. We made and matched playdough apples to number trees, and we used tweezers to pick up apple-colored pompoms and sort them on matching colored apple trees.



Literacy

This week we learned about the letter F. We continue to work really hard writing our names. New this week is learning about sound position. We would clap, stomp, snap and talk about what sound came first or last. Some books we read this week: "Apples," "Johnny Appleseed," "The Biggest Apple Ever," "Manzanas (Apples)," "Chicka Chicka 123," and "Apple Picking Day."
