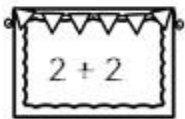
### Weekly Focus Wall

Shape: Oval      Color: Green



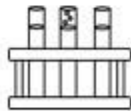
### Math

This week we focused on counting to 10 while doing movement. This was tricky at first because their movement didn't match their counting, but by the end of the week they all got it! We also practiced counting objects to 5. We learned about dice and counted each side. In centers we played a spooky ghost and bead counting game and counting flies in a spider web.



### Literacy

This week we learned about the letter I. We also reviewed all the letters we have already learned. Some concepts we worked on are initial sounds and identifying a word versus a letter. We had fun doing some spooky monster name writing during centers.
