

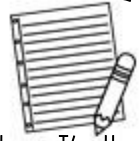

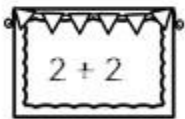


Math

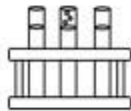
We continue to practice counting and moving to 10 and writing 1-10. We continue to review shape attributes for rectangle, circle, square, and triangle. We had fun using gingerbread 10's frames to counting little blocks and made gingerbread gumdrop patterns during centers.



This week we learned about the letter Q. We also reviewed all the letters we have already learned. We continue to practice clapping syllables in words and practiced finding words that look the same. For example, the word sat and hat was written on the board twice. Students had to circle hat two times. Some books we read this week: "The Gingerbread Man," "Gingerbread Baby," "The Gingerbread Man Loose at Christmas," "The Gingerbread Pirates," and "Nijabread Man."
