
Focus Wall

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Math

We continue to count out loud and do the correct number of movements. Each day this week we counted objects to 2 and during centers practiced writing the number 2. In centers we had lots of apple fun. We made and matched playdough apples to number trees, and we used tweezers to pick up apple-colored pompoms and sort them on matching colored apple trees.
