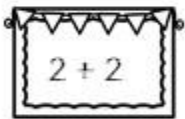
Math

We continue to count out loud and do the correct number of movements. We practiced counting objects to 3, 4, and 5. In centers we had fun counting fall counters and writing the number 3.



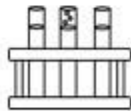
Literacy
