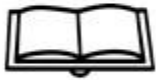
A Note From Ms. Woytych

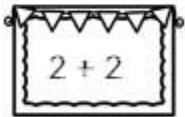
Classroom Procedures

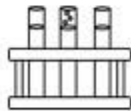
Math
